In accordance with the Archdiocese of Seattle's Code of Conduct, and to also be in line with what God calls us to and to also help us see one another in God's image, teens are not to wear revealing, in appropriate, or tight fitting clothing. This includes, but is not limited to:

- No tight fitting, revealing pants of any kind—loose sweats are O.K.
- Low cut shirts, mid-drift shirts, shirts that come up with arms are raised to reveal mid-drift
- Pants that sag
- Pants or shirts with holes in them in inappropriate, revealing places
- Shirts or pants with inappropriate language or images, such as but not limited to:
 - Drug or alcohol paraphernalia
 - Weapons
 - Inappropriate logos or images
 - Sexual content
 - Swear words or inappropriate language
- Short shorts or skirts

Parents, we appreciate your help in providing a safe, and faith-filled space for our teens! Teens, please be sure to look over the list, and a great general rule of thumb is: if you think you shouldn't wear it, you probably shouldn't.
